Peace Through Action USA seeks a regular volunteer or volunteers to serve as our fund development adviser. The adviser will guide us through the development of our first fundraising plan. Also, the adviser will implement some of the plan's components and coach the chief executive officer and board of directors on finance implementation.

Our ideal adviser will be a seasoned fundraising officer with expertise in both fundraising planning and execution and a desire and time availability to lend their knowledge and experience to a start-up organization with big ambitions, an unfolding mission delivery plan, and immediate finance needs.

We seek an adviser or advisers who can give eight-to-ten hours week per week time (at days and hours of their choice) for up to four-to-six months.
