Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 11b - The Peace Through Action USA chief executive officer and secretary disseminates a draft of the Form 990 to directors and provides them a period of time to review and comment on the information turn prior to its submission.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 12c - The chair reminds directors of the organization's conflict of interest policy and duty of directors to declare known conflicts of interest at the end of each calendar year, and as conflicts arise thereafter. Directors declare known conflicts of interest at the end of each calendar year by completing a director information collection renewal form. Directors with self-declared conflicts of interest and directors observing potential conflicts of interest by other directors notify the chair and secretary of such potential conflicts. The chair then schedules the board of directors to examine such potential conflicts at its next regular meeting, or at a special meeting if the circumstance requires a more prompt decision.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 15 - The board of directors has adopted a policy on executive compensation. The policy establishes to whom the policy applies and the steps the board of directors shall take in setting executive compensation. At present, the policy applies to the position of the chief executive officer. The board of directors last established the compensation range for the chief executive officer in 2017. Currently, the chief executive officer receives pay below the low end of the range.
